

Scott E. Smith Salty Salmon Foundation Inc.

The Scott E. Smith Salty Salmon Foundation Inc. was established to provide scholarships to current and former lacrosse players who play and/or played lacrosse to use for post - secondary education expenses at junior college, colleges or universities.

Criteria for the Scott E. Smith Salty Salmon Scholarship

Purpose: The Foundation awards scholarships to college-bound high school seniors who play or have played high school level lacrosse in a program recognized by the appropriate state lacrosse association and intend to continue playing lacrosse at a post-secondary level at a junior college, college or university in a program recognized by the NCAA, the MCLA, the NJCAA or the NCLL.

Criteria: The students eligible for assistance must be graduating high school seniors who participated in a high school lacrosse program recognized by the appropriate state lacrosse association and intend to continue their education at a junior college, college or university where they intend to participate in a lacrosse program recognized by the NCAA, the MCLA, the NJCAA or the NCLL. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, the student's growth as a lacrosse player, team play and leadership on and off the athletic field and community service. The goal is to recognize a student whose lacrosse participation best exemplifies the spirit Scott Smith personally demonstrated. Students should submit a scholarship application on the form provided by the Foundation. A letter of recommendation from the student's current high school lacrosse coach should be provided with the completed application.

Guidelines: Scholarship(s) will be awarded annually and disbursed upon verified enrollment. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college for the full award amount and not to the student. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the Foundation the invoice for tuition and fees, student ID number, and college information.

Amount: Each scholarship awarded will be \$3000. The scholarship is not renewable.

Deadline: The application deadline is **June 20, 2026.**
